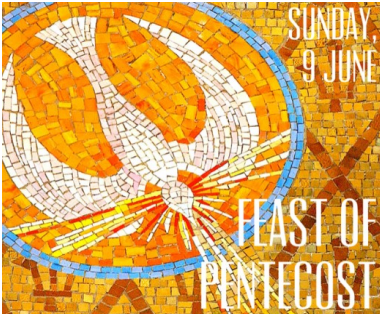

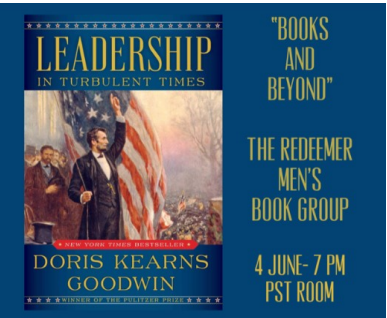

Dear People of God:

Summer definitely has arrived, and with it, for many of us, a change in routine. For us on the parish staff, it’s not necessarily less busy, but summer is a different kind of “busy.” I enjoy the change in routine and look forward to it.

I suspect you do, too. Families with children look forward to the summer break when schedules are more relaxed and you can take better advantage of myriad recreational opportunities. Many of our folks escape to cooler climes for at least part of the summer.



It’s good to have a change in routine and to relax our schedules. Of course, the daily schedule of services at Redeemer remains the same pretty much year-round. Every day, Monday through Saturday, we have Morning Prayer at 8:30, Mass at 10, and on Monday through Friday Evening Prayer at 5:15. We have an additional weekday mass on Wednesday at 7:30 AM and Thursday at 5:30 PM. We have five weekend masses: our contemporary Mass on Saturday at 5:30, and on Sunday a “said” Rite I Mass at 7:30 a.m., a choral Rite II Mass at 9, a choral Rite I Mass at 11, and Mass in Spanish at 1 p.m.

I recommend taking advantage of the opportunity to change your routine in the summer, but may I suggest that if you want to include the Church in that change of routine, don’t drop it from your list of things you do, but include it in your changes. Go to the museum on Sunday morning, but plan ahead so that you can go to the 5:30 Saturday night Mass. if you’re used to Rite I, attend a Rite II Mass, or *vice versa*. Or sleep in on Sunday morning and attend the Spanish Mass. You might not understand a word, but you’ll know exactly what’s going on because it’s the same thing that we do at all of our other Masses! Do some shopping on a weekday in downtown Sarasota and make the 10 AM Mass part of your experience. Look at our calendar and mix and match, breaking your routine a little, while at the same time expanding your experience of what we do at Redeemer (and keeping your Sunday obligation at the same time).

Variety is the spice of life, the saying goes, and summer is a great time to build some variety into your routine. Don’t forget to include the Church in your plans!
