

IN THE BEGINNING...


It's the beginning of a new month at Redeemer.

Dear People of God,

On Sunday, 11 August, Fr. Wood preached a rousing sermon in which he asked the question, "What Is Redeemer's greatest treasure?" It just so happens that the day before, 10 August, was the feast of Saint Lawrence, Deacon and Martyr, who died in the year A.D. 258.

Lawrence's responsibility as a deacon was to oversee the material goods of the Church. He was arrested and the prefect demanded that he surrender the treasures of the Church to the government. Instead of bringing forth the material goods, he brought forward the poor, to whom he had distributed alms, also one of his responsibilities as a deacon. Lawrence said, "Behold in these poor persons the treasures which I promised to show you; to which I will add pearls and




precious stones, those widows and consecrated virgins, which are the Church's crown." Enraged by his response, the prefect had a large gridiron brought out, had Lawrence placed on it, and had a large fire built beneath it. After he had suffered pain for a long time, the legend concludes, Lawrence cheerfully declared: "I'm well done on this side. Turn me over!" Images of St. Lawrence always include a gridiron, the instrument of his martyrdom.

Fr. Wood answered his own question by saying the treasure of Redeemer is our relationship with Jesus Christ. I would like add to his answer with a corollary, and that is the treasure of Redeemer is her people. This parish is blessed immeasurably by the hundreds of people who are devoted to our Lord Jesus Christ and who express that devotion in countless ways through the giving of their time, talent, and treasure to the glory of God and the building up of his Church in this place.

As we begin a new program year, I am thankful that we are building upon the foundation laid by the apostles and martyrs, our Lord Jesus Christ himself being the chief cornerstone. I am thankful for the many talented and dedicated people of this parish, who make Redeemer such a rich and varied treasure.

There is always room for more! Won't you take your place in the work and ministry of Church of the Redeemer?
