

IN THE **BEGINNING...**


It's the beginning of a new month at Redeemer.

Dear People of God:

Remember this month, October 2019. This is the month during which our new classroom and multipur pose building is to be completed! Thanks be to God!

This new building is a culmination of the vision of the leaders of our parish at least over the last 25 years. When I first came to Redeemer as a new rector, your vestry and other leaders in the parish recognized that the space we have available on Sunday morning for instruction basically only allowed us to do instruction for children and youth, with one class for adults in Gillespie Hall. Our first attempt to deal with the situation ended with the construction of a small structure behind the high altar facing Palm Avenue. With that structure, we added space for our flower, brass, and candle committees, acolytes, Gift Shoppe, and four classrooms (One of the classrooms ended up becoming our print room, since it was replaced by an office for our new youth minister). The other three classrooms were really too small for any of our classes, so it became basically one classroom. This addition allowed us to add



one small adult class.

Every strategic plan that we developed over the years had at the top of the list the need for more space on Sunday morning. In 2008, we were poised to begin a building campaign when the economy collapsed. All plans were shelved.

When the economy recovered, our new strategic plan once again called for more space. Once again we forged ahead with a building plan. This time it worked! Our new building should be ready to be occupied by All Saints' Day 2019, given the willingness of the city to give us a Certificate of Occupancy!


In this new building, all of our classrooms will now be on the second floor. There is a new multi-purpose room on the third floor, with a beautiful balcony overlooking the bay. The offices will now be on the first floor of the building, opening up space in the old office building for more meeting rooms, a youth room, and a parlor which can be used as a brides' room, as a place for small receptions, and for families to gather before the requiems of their loved ones.

Always remember that all of our buildings at the corner of Palm and Ringling are for one purpose: the glory of God and the building up of his Church. They are for the purpose of strengthening the people of God for the work of mission. They are a part of our mission every bit as much as, for example, Day for Hope or any of the other forms of outreach in which we are engaged. In fact, if it were not for what takes place in these buildings day after day, the many wonderful things that we do for mission away from our property would not happen. It is my hope and expectation that what you have enabled to happen will truly expand our capacity for mission beyond our walls.

This building simply could not have been possible without the sacrificial gifts of many. Words are inadequate to express my thanks for your generosity and vision.

Make your plans now to be present for the dedication by Bp. Smith scheduled for Sunday, 8 December, between the 9 and 11 o'clock masses.
