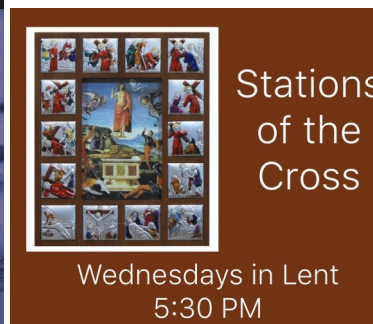

Dear Parish Family,

As Senior Warden, I wanted to provide answers to frequently-asked questions as our search process begins:



1. Has a Search Committee been chosen?
The current Vestry will serve as the Search Committee. The Vestry represents all five Sunday services and most of Redeemer’s ministries.
2. How can members of the congregation participate in the search?
First, a parish survey will be distributed in early March, and it is vitally important that everyone voice their opinions and comments, as the results are essential to the search process. Second, keep Church of the Redeemer, the Vestry, our clergy and staff, and our entire parish family in prayer throughout this discernment period.
3. How will our rector’s position be advertised?
After we have the results of our parish survey, it will posted in many places, including the Living Church, Episcopal News Service, The Episcopal Church, and the Diocese of SW Florida.
4. Who is eligible to be considered? Is current staff excluded? Is there an age requirement?
Those on our staff are eligible, as well as anyone else who might apply. There is no age requirement.
5. Who will make the final decision on who our new rector will be?
The Vestry makes the final decision, along with a blessing of the Bishop.
6. What role does Bishop Smith play in the process?
Bishop Smith has been guiding us through the process, and will continue to do so.
7. Generally, how long does the search process take?
As we know, God knows who our next rector will be. It is our job to listen where He leads. This discernment period takes time, sometimes over a year. There is no absolute timeline.
8. Who is in charge in the interim?
By canon law, the Senior Warden is charge of the parish in the absence of the rector. We are considering putting a priest-in-charge in place to serve throughout the process, who would have all the authority of the Rector without tenure. (Note: a priest-in-charge is eligible to become the Rector). We are currently consulting with the Bishop on this, and we will use our survey results to help make this decision.
9. When a new rector is selected, when will that person be introduced to the parish?
Introduction to the parish will take place after hiring.
