The procession heads directly to Gillespie Hall, with all the adult leaders, to prepare a series of meaningful Holy Week frozen tableaus, depicting the seven main events in Christ's life between Palm Sunday and Easter Day. These are presented by them in the service, just before The Peace. No rehearsal is needed, and all are invited to participate. Post-presentation, children and youth head to sit with their families.

After church, we head out to the parish lawn for the annual Palm Sunday Petting Zoo.
